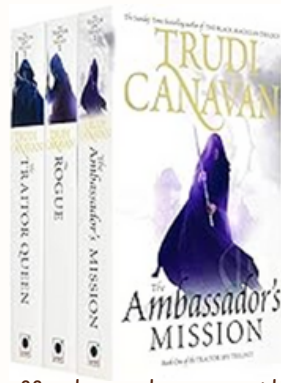
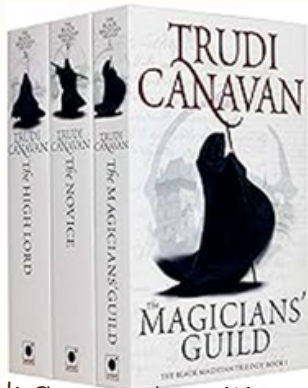
GCSE EXAMS

FEATURED FANTASY BOOKS



Trudi Canavan's writing career took off when she won the Aurealis Award for Best Fantasy Short Story with Whispers of the Mist Children. She further established herself with The Magicians' Guild, centring on Sonea, a slum child who is hunted for her rogue magic. The novel, which was the first of three books of The Black Magician Trilogy, brought her widespread acclaim, and the second book of the trilogy, The Novice was nominated for the Aurealis Award for Best Fantasy Novel. The third book, The High Lord, was nominated for the Best Novel Ditmar category. All three books entered Australian top ten SF best-seller lists. The trilogy has been translated into German, Dutch, Italian, Polish, Portuguese, Czech, Danish, Spanish and French.

Canavan's second trilogy, Age of the Five, was also well received by her readers. The first in the series, Priestess of the White reached No.3 in the Sunday Times hardback fiction best-seller list, staying in the top ten for 6 weeks. The Magician's Apprentice came next and Canavan's third trilogy, The Traitor Spy trilogy, is a sequel to the Black Magician Trilogy. All of these books are available in our library.

C2 COMPUTER ROOM



In normal school times **C2** is available for students before school, at lunch time (not Break) and after school for students to use for homework or SORA but not to play games. The Library is also a **Never Seen Never Heard** no phone zone so students are reminded to email their homework in before coming to school.

The very tired, well-worn furniture in the library has been upgraded.

Bright coloured Posture+ wipe clean chairs and 6 red Faux Leather tub chairs have brightened up the area and students have been very positive to the change. The library C2 computer suite has also been upgraded with new chairs too.

The displays have focussed on Year 7 books to encourage reluctant readers and I have purchased exciting new titles for them. I have also rearranged the spinners into genres to match the shelves and Reader Friendly books for dyslexic readers. Several new Graphic novels have also been purchased. Novels featured in different countries, celebrations for Christmas, Easter, Six Nations, Science Fiction, Theatre & Drama and of course World Book Day have all been displayed as well as our continuing displays on neurodiversity, mental health and well-being.

HE'S COMING TO THORNDEN!

For his award-winning Young Samurai series, he trained in iaido (samurai swordmanship), karate, ninjutsu and earned his black belt in Zen Kyu Shin Taijutsu. Previously he has trained in judo, muay thai and kickboxing. For his BODYGUARD series, Chris embarked on an intensive close protection course to become a qualified professional bodyguard. During his training, he acquired skills in unarmed combat, defensive driving, tactical firearms, threat assessments, surveillance, and even anti-ambush exercises. For the Soul trilogy, Chris travelled extensively to experience first-hand the cultures featured in the story – from living with the Shona people in Zimbabwe, to trekking the Inca trail, to meditating in a Buddhist temple amid the mountains of Japan.

Students in Year 8 will be thoroughly entertained by Chris on Thursday 5th July 2024.

Follow London's newest detective, Enola Holmes, in her electrifying escapades - from the series that inspired the films, starring Millie Bobby Brown.

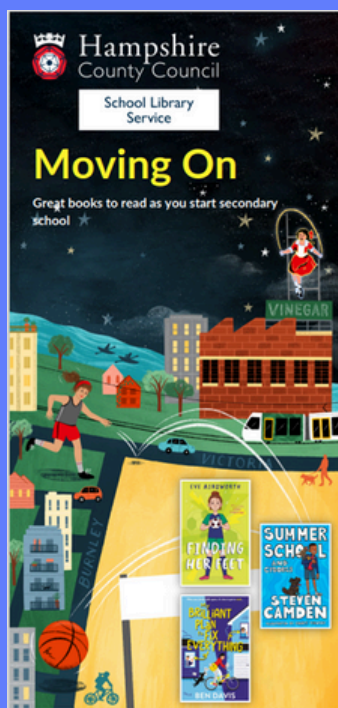


LOKI
