APPRENTICESHIPS

An apprenticeship is a real job where you learn, gain experience and get paid. (80% on the job, 20% in education)

You are an employee with a contract of employment and paid holiday leave.

By the end of an apprenticeship, you'll have the right skills and knowledge needed for your chosen career

It can take between one and 6 years to complete an apprenticeship depending on which one you choose, what level it is and your previous experience.

There are several levels of apprenticeships. You will need to look for L3: ADVANCED LEVEL apprenticeships (equivalent to A Level qualifications)

BENEFITS OF APPRENTICESHIPS

Apprenticeships are an exciting option - you get handson training and also the chance to put your skills into practice.

You get to earn money while you learn. What you will earn varies depending on the apprenticeship you choose.

Apprenticeships are funded from contributions made by the government and your employer. This means you will not have any student loans or tuition fees. You will just need to cover the cost of your day-to-day expenses, such as lunch and travel.

You can continue apprenticeships at degree level
